Due to new regulations from state and county health officials, MUST Ministries can no longer accept sandwiches that are made outside of certified kitchens for their Summer Lunch Program. Since St. Peter & St. Paul does not have a certified kitchen, we will be unable to make and package sandwiches on site this year for that program. Our only options in this regard are the following:

1. Become a certified kitchen (this cannot to be accomplished in time for June sandwich making).
2. Make the sandwiches in the MUST kitchen or find another certified kitchen.
3. Make a donation to MUST to purchase ready-made sandwiches from a certified vendor.

As time is running short, we have decided to go with option #3. Money from our Summer Lunch budget that would normally go towards sandwich supplies will be put towards the purchase of ready-made ones instead. I know many of you look forward to coming together for fun and fellowship while making sandwiches to feed our Cobb County children during the summer. However, we can still get together each Sunday in June to prep and fill lunch sacks with snacks and drinks to accompany the sandwiches just as we have in the past. We will need bag openers, stuffers, and packers to put together our 1000 snack bags each week, so mark your calendars for the first 4 Sundays in June: 2, 9, 16, & 23.
